The Sun Cycle in Libra 2023

It's time to strike a balance! "Where?" you might ask. From my viewpoint, it seems

The Sun enters Libra on September 23<sup>rd</sup> at 2:50 AM EDT. "Gird your loins."

The Autumnal Equinox—happening when the Sun shifts into Libra on September 23<sup>rd</sup> —marks the time when the hours of daylight and night are equal. From this time forward through the vernal equinox on March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024, days will be shorter as the light slowly diminishes. This sixmonth period invites us to focus on both the inner and external needs in our lives.

Early in the Libra cycle, the **Full Moon in Aries** (September 29th at 5:58 AM EDT) stimulates strong passion that can be directed toward tremendous creative expression and may bring just the right fuel to achieve the goals each person feels ready to tackle. Relationships may take top priority, although the greatest challenge may arise from addressing your own needs as you move through your personal growth and transformation. Near the time of the solar eclipse, the Sun, Moon, Mercury and Mars are all joining forces that can raise the intensity of whatever is going on.

The Sabian Symbol for the zodiac degree of the Sun at the time of the eclipse is: "A CHILD GIVING BIRDS A DRINK AT A FOUNTAIN." This particular image carries qualities of tender curiosity, while showing concern beyond oneself. There is innocence present. What do you see in your mind's eye when you think of this image?

The Lunar Eclipse that accompanies this Solar Eclipse will peak on October 28th. The period between the two eclipses marks an excellent time to clarify what is happening and to take time to let go of what has ended or is no longer reflecting what brings harmony and balance in your life.
